ELECTION DAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2014, IS HERE: County Clerk Stan Stanart Urges Voters To Be Prepared

Houston, TX – “Prior to voting on Election Day, November 4th, I encourage everyone to visit www.HarrisVotes.com to find your polling location, your personal sample ballot, and review the list of approved voting credentials,” urges Harris County Clerk Stan Stanart.

Polls on Tuesday, November 4th, Election Day, will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

“Voters should know where their poll is located before heading to vote,” said Stanart, the chief election official of the county. “Remember, voters must vote at their designated precinct on Election Day. In addition, I encourage everyone to do their homework, review the candidates, review the issues, and make an informed vote.”

According to Stanart, early voting went extremely well in the third-largest county in the nation due to voter preparedness. Many voters could be seen in the voting lines with printed copies of their personal sample ballot which they obtained from www.HarrisVotes.com, the County Clerk’s Election webpage. Moreover, many voters had their photo ID in hand. As a result, voting lines moved at a good pace for the over 307,000 early voters in Harris County.

“The full Harris County Sample Ballot is 11 pages long, because it has every race in the county. If you use www.HarrisVotes.com to look up your personal ballot, you will typically find your ballot is under 3 pages long. All of the information you need to be prepared to vote in Harris County is available in English, Spanish, Vietnamese and Chinese on www.HarrisVotes.com, the Election Hotline (713.755.6965) and at the polls on Election Day,” informs Stanart.
